NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 at 7 p.m. at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes to consider the following:

Code Amendment (ZON2017-00430) – A request to consider adopting an ordinance amending Title 17 (Zoning) and Title 5 (Business Taxes, Licenses and Regulations) of the Rancho Palos Verdes Municipal Code to prohibit commercial marijuana activities in all zoning districts of the City.

LOCATION: Citywide

APPLICANT: City of Rancho Palos Verdes

On October 3, 2017, the City Council initiated said code amendment. On October 10, 2017, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing and adopted P.C. Resolution No. 2017-36, recommending that the City Council adopt an ordinance amending Title 17 (Zoning) of the Municipal Code to prohibit commercial marijuana activities in all zoning districts of the City.
