NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, November 4, 2020, at 7:00 PM. Pursuant to Section 3 of [Executive Order N-29-20](#), issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the regular meeting of the City Council for November 4, 2020, will be conducted through a hybrid combination of in-person attendance with not less than three members of the City Council, invited staff, and limited members of the public at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on RPVtv channels Cox 33 and Frontier FiOS 38. The City Council will consider the following:
