### **NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, September 21, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Pursuant to Section 3 of [Executive Order N-29-20](#), issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the regular meeting of the City Council for September 21, 2021, will be conducted through a hybrid combination of in-person attendance with not less than three members of the City Council, and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at [rpvca.gov/agendas](http://rpvca.gov/agendas) and on RPTV channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. Please note that depending on the COVID-19 circumstances in the following weeks, an amended notice may be issued on the change from a virtual meeting to a regular meeting at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes.

**REVISION “GGG” TO THE TRUMP NATIONAL GOLF CLUB PROJECT  
CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CASE NO. PLCU2020-0009)** – A request to revise Conditions of Approval No. Z.44 to allow Lot No. 11 of Tract No. 50667 to build up to 26 feet in height, as measured from the point of entry of a proposed subterranean garage and exterior patio basement level. The proposed residence, as measured from the highest existing grade elevation established in the Vesting Tentative Tract Map No. 50667, will not exceed the 16 feet height limit.
