## **NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on December 9, 2014, the City of Rancho Palos Verdes **APPROVED** a Coastal Permit and Conditional Use Permit (Planning Case No. ZON2014-00332). All City appeals have been exhausted, and the City's decision is now final.

Said decision is in conjunction with the <u>APPROVAL</u> of a Conditional Use Permit to allow the conversion of a portion of the Harden Estate Gatehouse at 5500 Palos Verdes Drive South into the "Palos Verdes Heritage Museum," which lies within the City's Coastal Specific Plan District.

In **APPROVING** this Coastal Permit, the following findings **were** made:

- 1. That the proposed development is in conformance with the Coastal Specific Plan; and,
- 2. That the proposed development, when located between the sea and the first public road, is in conformance with applicable public access and recreation policies of the Coastal Act.

Since the project is located in an **Appealable Area** of the City's Coastal Specific Plan district, this decision may be appealed to the California Coastal Commission.
