**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 16, 2021, at 7:00 PM., The meeting will take place remotely in accordance with Government Code Section 54953(e) et seq. (AB 361), and will be conducted through a \*hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the five members of the City Council and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at [rpvca.gov/agendas](http://rpvca.gov/agendas) and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiberOptic 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. The City Council will consider the following:

**Miscellaneous Hearing for Green Hills Memorial Park Rooftop Use of Inspiration Slope Mausoleum (Case No. PLMH2021-0001):**

**Slope Mausoleum (Case No. PLMH2021-0001):** On January 1, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-03 for the Green Hills Memorial Park to allow various revisions to the conditions of approval. This resolution included various conditions modified and/or added in 2018, including Condition of Approval No. 1.f, which states that rooftop interments shall be subject to City Council review as described in Condition No. 2b. Pursuant to Condition of Approval No. 1.f, and a report received and filed by the City Council on July 19, 2016, Green Hills Memorial Park submitted a request to begin utilizing the permitted and previously installed concrete vaults for burials.
