

Public Notice

2016 PV Half-Marathon, 5K & 10K Run/Walk, & Expo event on November 19, 2016

October 6, 2016

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- Vehicular traffic along Palos Verdes Drive South between Hawthorne Blvd and Narcissa Drive will be limited to one lane going in each direction on the landward side portion of the roadway from 6:30 AM to 11:00 AM on the day of the race. Vehicular traffic along Palos Verdes Drive West between Hawthorne Blvd and the City's northerly border with Palos Verdes Estates will be on both sides of the street with a portion of the ocean side of the roadway blocked off for two-way runner circulation. Residential neighborhoods along the course with exclusive access to Palos Verdes Drive South and Palos Verdes Drive West between the City's northerly border at Palos Verdes Estates and Narcissa Drive will have to use specific streets to exit the neighborhood and may experience delays during the event, particularly between the hours of 3:00 AM and 11:00 AM.
- The partial closure of streets that comprise the race course will begin at 6:30 AM and all streets will be re-opened by 11:00 AM.
- Event parking is being provided at three different off-site locations: Rancho Palos Verdes City Hall, the Salvation Army property and the Pointe Vicente Interpretive Center (PVIC) with shuttle service available only from City Hall. Parking areas will open at 5:00 AM and close by 1:00 PM.
- Parking by race participants in residential neighborhoods near the race start/finish area will be discouraged by the placement of "No Event Parking" signs.
- No public trails in the race area will be closed during the event. Abalone Cove State Park will remain open during the event, with a Sheriff Deputy to control ingress/egress. The public parking spaces off Calle Entradero and at the Pointe Vicente Interpretive Center parking lot will remain open during the event, with volunteers and Sheriff Deputies controlling ingress/egress, respectively. Public parking for coastal trail users will be provided at specified locations at the Terranea Resort and at the PVIC.
- This temporary event is excluded from coastal development permit requirements pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 30610 (i).

Please submit your concerns in writing to the Community Development Director within fifteen (15) days of the date of this notice, or by 4:30 pm on Friday, October 21, 2016. By doing so, you will ensure that your comments are taken into consideration when a decision is made on the application. The decision will be made after the 15-day public notification period.

The Director's decision on the permit request may be appealed, in writing, to the Planning Commission. The appeal letter, which must set forth the grounds of the appeal and any specific actions request by the appellant, must be filed within five (5) calendar days of the date of decision and must be accompanied by a \$2,275.00 appeal fee. Written materials, including emails, submitted to the City are public records and may be posted on the City's website. In addition, City meetings may be televised and may be accessed through the City's website. Accordingly, you may wish to omit personal information from your written materials.
